

Howling Cow Camp 2021 will be held July 5-16, 2021. The camp will take place at the NC State Dairy Farm located on Lake Wheeler Rd. (301 Dairy Lane, Raleigh, 27603) The camp will run from Monday through Friday from 9am to 4pm. Campers will get hands on experience with a dairy heifer. This camp will help build confidence in young people as they learn how to work directly with large animals. Campers will also learn the daily tasks of feeding and cleaning on a dairy farm. By the end of the two weeks a camper will know: How to halter and lead their heifer, the rules of showmanship when showing dairy animals and how to judge the physical attributes of dairy animals. Campers will learn what cows eat to make milk and how dairy products are a part of a healthy diet. We will visit the processing facility where all Howling Cow Dairy Products are processed. We will learn the role of Veterinarians on a dairy farm. Campers will learn how to groom and prepare their heifer for a show. This camp is designed to bring youth who are interested in working with dairy animals more in-depth knowledge about dairy cows. The camp will culminate at the Greensboro District Jr. Dairy Show. The show will take place in Greensboro on July 16th, the last day of camp. We will encourage parents and families to attend the show on the 16th.
